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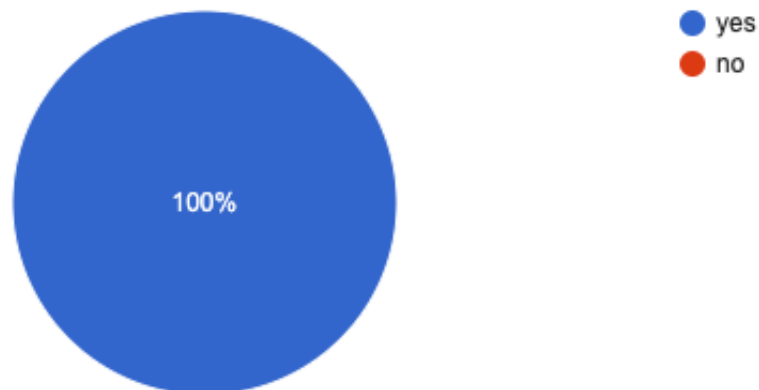
FINAL TEACHERS SURVEY REPORT

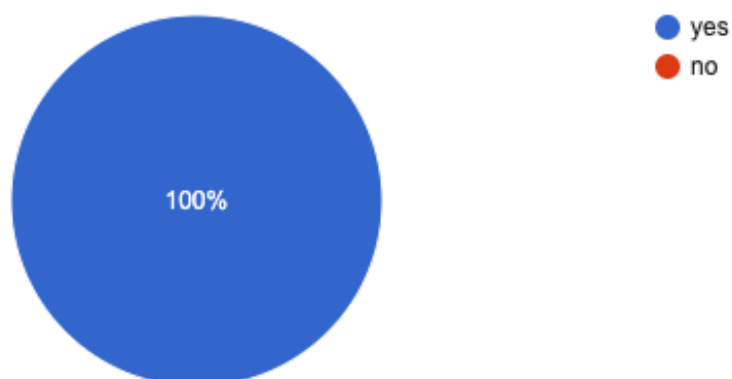

during the erasmus experience I was able to improve my English language skills, I discussed with colleagues on the issues of sustainability and meaningful learning

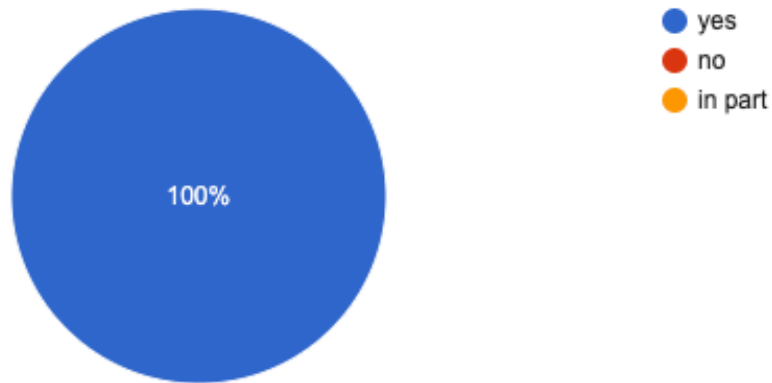
Do you find satisfactory the advertising activities started by our Institute on the Erasmus Project ?

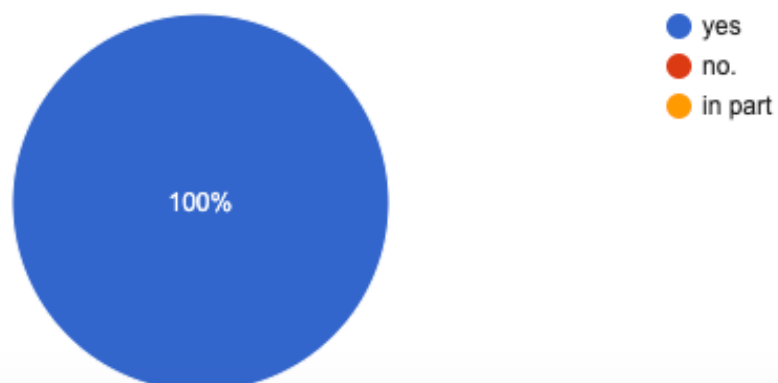

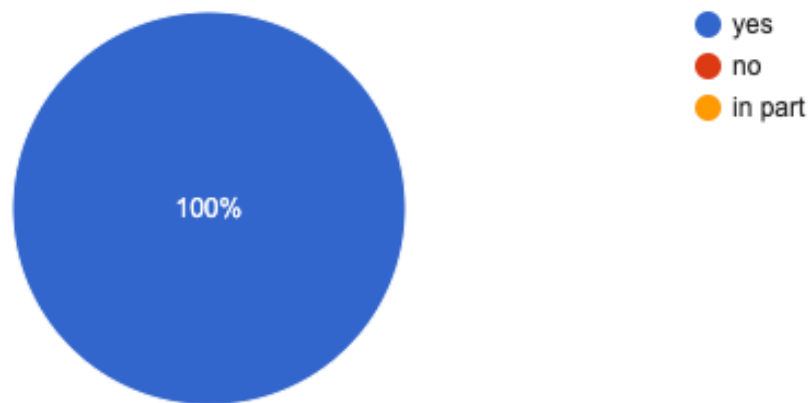

With the Erasmus team we met the principal of this school Albert Murjas who is a person who has shown particular attention to foreign languages as he considers them the key to success! His school has bilingual departments and we noticed attention paid to educating students to prevent risky situations and to adopt responsible behaviors. The school is very large and spacious, there is a lot of attention to the greenery and spaces. The staff, teachers are very helpful, thanks to which the atmosphere is pleasant. The school operates, it is well equipped with themed classrooms.
